Colleges and universities will do mini-presentations about their school. These presentations will be a maximum of three minutes long. There will be a timer (**me**) but I won't run you off the stage—hopefully. Things that you may want to include in presentation:

- **A barrage of enrollment size**
- **Student to faculty ratios**
- **Average class sizes**
- **Test scores**

Finally, there will be a counselor college fair after the presentations for you to go more in depth about your institution. The counselor's college fair will allow for more informal conversations to take place. Colleges and universities may provide information on their institutions. 25 to 30 packets should be a safe for a guideline. Also don't forget your pennants, posters or other promotional materials that your school displays.

After the fair we are serving lunch and expect the event to be over no later than **2:00 pm**.
